## **CONTEST RULES**

### **Float Contest-**

Your float must include the following elements to be considered for a prize:

- Be inspired by a Christmas story
- Have the story's title clearly displayed
- Submit a written paragraph (5-6 sentences) explaining your float, which will be read to the crowd as your float travels past the judges, **MAXIMUM** of a 1 minute stop in front of judges

- If you choose to play music, it must be appropriate for all ages and Christmas themed
- Be at the county yard no later than 3 pm

Each judge will be judging your float on the following criteria with a scale of 1 to 5; the prizes will be given to the highest scoring float:

- Creativity
- Use of lights
- Story's representation
- Participants walking with or showcased on your float, quality not quantity

## **Marching Unit-**

Your marching unit must include the following elements to be considered for a prize:

- A minimum of 8 participants
- Banner with organization/group's identity
- Submit a written paragraph (2-3 sentences) explaining your unit, which will be read to the crowd as your unit travels past the judges, **MAXIMUM** of a 1 minute stop in front of judges
- Be at the county yard no later than 5 pm

Each judge will be judging your marching unit on the following criteria with a scale of 1 to 5; the prizes will be given to the highest scoring unit:

- Creativity (shirts, costumes, etc.)
- Participants, quality not quantity
- Banner

#### **Tree Contest-**

Your tree must include the following elements to be considered for a prize:

- NOT be taller than 5 feet
- Clearly labeled somewhere, somehow with organization/group's identity
- Be at Mitchell Pauole Center no later than 1 pm ready to judge

Each judge will be judging your tree on the following criteria with a scale of 1 to 5; the prizes will be given to the highest scoring tree:

- Creativity
- Use of lights & ornaments

## **Stocking & Wreath Contest-**

Please have your entries to Mitchell Pauole Center no later than 1 pm with your name clearly labeled somewhere, somehow on it. Entries will be judged based on creativity. Have fun with the kids! And remember ages 4-11 ONLY!
