# CONTEST RULES

## FLOAT CONTEST

Your float must include the following elements to be considered for a prize:

- . Be inspired by a Christmas story
- . Have the story's title clearly displayed
- . Submit a written paragraph (5-6 sentences) explaining your float, which will be read to the crowd as your float travels toward the judges.
- . If you choose to play music, it must be appropriate for all ages and Christmas themed
- . For safety reasons, **DO NOT** throw candies to the crowd from the float. Your walkers are allowed to hand candies out, but not throw while walking with the float.
- . Be at the county yard no later than 4 p.m. and report to the parade coordinator for line-up assignment.
- . Please dispose of your float opala before and after the parade.

## FLOAT JUDGING:

Each judge's points on a scale of 1-5 will be based on the following criteria:

- . Creativity
- . Use and display of lights
- . Story's presentation
- . Participants walking with or showcased on your float, quality not quantity.

## MARCHING UNIT

Your marching unit must include the following elements to be considered for a prize:

- . A minimum of 8 (eight) participants
- . Banner with organization/group's identity
- . Submit a written paragraph (2-3) sentences explaining your unit, which will be announced to the crowd as your unit travels toward the judges.
- . Be at the County yard no later than 5 p.m. and report to the parade coordinator for line-up assignment.
- . For safety reasons, DONOT throw candies to the crowd, but you may hand out candies.
- . Please dispose of your opala before and after the parade.

## MARCHING UNIT JUDGING:

Each judge's points on a scale of 1-5 will be based on the following criteria:

- . Creativity (shirts, costumes, etc.)
- . Participants, quality not quantity
- . Theme presentation (song, dance, etc.)
- . Banner

## **CHRISTMAS TREE CONTEST (Open to all ages)**

Your tree must include the following elements to be considered for a prize:

- **NOT** taller than 5 feet
- Please provide a label with your name/organization or group that can be hung on the tree **after** the judging is done. The label may be given to the Tree Contest Coordinator in the designated Hexagon White Tent.
- Be at the designated Hexagon White Tent at the Kaunakakai Ball Park no later than 1pm ready to judge.

Each judge will be judging your tree on the following criteria with a scale of 1 to 5; the prizes will be given to the highest scoring tree

- Creativity
- Use of lights and ornaments
